
1st Workshop: The LGM in the Alps

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Programme

December 5th: Arrival at the University of Udine in the late afternoon, inspection of the Azzano X core, discussion of the long succession that ends with the LGM distal outwash deposits of the Tagliamento system.

December 6th: Field trip to the upper Piedmont plain and Tagliamento end moraine system. Discussion of the stratigraphy and chronology of the last glaciation. Short plenary discussion session at the University of Udine in the afternoon.

December 7th: Field trip to the outlet of the Isonzo/Soca River, discussion of the chronology and palaeovegetational records. Transfer to train station or airport in the late afternoon.

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Venue
